

## **Terms of Reference**

### **1 PURPOSE**

The Spatial Information Committee (SICOM) will provide a forum for the exchange of information on spatial activities between a broad cross section of the South Australian spatial community.

### **2 TERMS OF REFERENCE**

1. To provide a forum for the exchange of information on spatial initiatives, projects and applications.
2. To promote awareness and effective spatial information management within State, Local and Commonwealth Government agencies, industry and education.
3. To contribute towards the development of national and State policies and standards relating to spatial information.
4. To contribute towards the implementation of national spatial information initiatives.
5. To facilitate two-way communication between the State and National spatial information committees.

### **3 MEMBERSHIP**

Membership of SICOM will consist of representatives from State, Local and Commonwealth Government, education, industry and professional bodies that currently have a significant investment or interest in spatial information.

SICOM will be chaired by the Director of Environmental Information, Department for Environment and Heritage.

### **4 MEETING FREQUENCY**

The Committee will meet quarterly on the first Friday of the month in February, May, August and November.

### **5 TERM**

The Terms of Reference for SICOM will be reviewed every 12 months.

### **6 SUPPORT**

SICOM will be supported administratively through the Environmental Information Directorate of the Department for Environment and Heritage.

SICOM may establish or disband working groups to undertake particular investigations or projects.
